Scholarship(s) will be awarded in the amount up to \$1000.00 each.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

To receive this scholarship an applicant must (1) be a member or the son or daughter of an active 3rd degree member in good standing with the Knights of Columbus #2153, (2) be a high school graduate, (3) have applied for admission to, a recognized institution of higher learning.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

An applicant will be given consideration for the scholarship after a completed application has been received by the scholarship committee.

REIMBURSEMENT:

The scholarship money will be awarded to the recipient upon presentation of a current registration receipt from the educational institution or with notification of registration where a payment will be addressed directly to the institution of higher learning. Recipients will be presented the scholarship monies at the annual Knights of Columbus appreciation night held in July, at the St. Michael Family Center.

Application must be completed and received by the Knights of Columbus scholarship committee by **May 3rd**.
