The required Immunization State Report was sent to the State.</li> <li>• Vision and Hearing Screenings are almost complete. The referral process has begun.</li> <li>• At Risk for Diabetes Screening was done for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade during the Healthy High at the Weimar Elementary School on Tuesday, November 6, 2018. The 5<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade screening will be done in December during the WJHS Healthy High.</li> <li>• Spinal Screenings will be done this Fall during the Healthy High for the 5<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade girls and 8<sup>th</sup> grade boys as per the new Texas State Law.</li> <li>• Health Office visits have mainly been for injuries, headaches, Asthma and stomach virus. No cases of the flu.</li> </ul>
