Scholarship Information

The Weimar Methodist Foundation is offering one \$6,000 scholarship to a four-year college or university.

The scholarship will be divided equally over eight semesters, four in the Fall and four in the Spring. If the recipient so chooses, the scholarship can cover summer sessions as well, provided the total number of semesters adds up to eight. Furthermore, if the winner graduates in less than eight semesters, any unpaid semesters may be applied to graduate school (at the discretion of the Foundation.)

In order to maintain the scholarship, the recipient must remain in good academic standing. The recipient must mail proof of enrollment (a transcript or fee statement will suffice) to the treasurer of the Foundation. Upon receipt, the treasurer will cut a check directly to the Financial Aid office at the college or university.

Attached is the scholarship application. Please complete all sections using additional paper as necessary.

Applications for the 2019 scholarship are due to the Weimar High School counselor on or before Friday, April 26, 2019 with the winner announced in May.
