Welcome to Dyslexia Class— I'm so happy you are here! Reading by Design is the Dyslexia program that we use in Weimar ISD. It is a systematic, multisensory approach aligned with research-based practices for developing literacy. Each lesson follows a predictable routine: Phonological Awareness, Alphabet (which includes high frequency words), Reading Deck cards, New Learning, Reading Practice, Handwriting, Spelling, and Components of Language. There are 5 volumes in the Reading by Design program. There are mastery checks embedded in the volumes. This is done individually with your student and gives me information on what they are retaining and applying as well as what I need to go back and reteach for better understanding.

Our Learning Focus

Your child will be seen 4 times a week for 45 minutes for their Dyslexia intervention. I have attached the scope and sequence for the volume that your child is starting off this year. Attendance is very important for this program. It must be learned and taught with fidelity. This program builds on prior learning daily. Please ensure your student is at school! I look forward to working with your child this year!
