Weimar Junior High School, and the parents of the students participating in activities, services, and programs funded by Title I, Part A of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA), agree that this compact outlines how the parents, the entire school staff, and the students will share the responsibility for improved student academic achievement and the means by which the school and parents will build and develop a partnership that will help our students meet the State's high standards.

This school-parent compact is in effect during the school year 2022-2023.

The School's Responsibility:

Weimar Junior High School will:

1. Provide high-quality curriculum and instruction in a supportive and effective learning environment that enables the participating children to meet the State's student academic achievement standards by:
 - a. Creating learner-centered classrooms that develop critical thinkers who collaborate by using their strengths to develop strong communication skills and be adaptive in our global society.
2. Hold parent-teacher conferences (at least annually in elementary schools) during which the compact will be discussed as it relates to the individual child's achievement. Specifically, those conferences will be held:

4. Provide parents reasonable access to staff. Specifically, staff will be available for consultation with parents as follows:
 - a. Weimar Junior High staff members are available daily during their conference times to meet with parents. However, WJH staff members will gladly accommodate times to best meet the needs of the parent's schedule.
5. Provide parents opportunities to volunteer and participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities as follows:
 - a. Weimar Junior High encourages parents to participate at school-hosted functions and special events. Parents are welcome to observe their student's classroom lessons and activities.

The Scholar's Responsibilities:
