GRADING/PROGRESS REPORTS TO PARENTS:
EXAMINATIONS

EXEMPTIONS

To increase student attendance, the District shall allow exemptions for mid-term and final examinations for all students in grades 9, 10, 11, and 12.

Any student who has an average of 90 or above with no more than three absences and no more than three days in ISS and no expulsions or AEP days shall be exempt from the mid-term/final examination in that class.

Any student who has an average of 80 or above with no more than two absences and no more than three days in ISS and no expulsions or AEP days shall be exempt from the mid-term/final examination in that class.

Any student who has an average of 70 or above with no more than one absence and no more than three days in ISS and no expulsions or AEP days shall be exempt from the mid-term/final examination in that class.

FINAL
EXAMINATIONS

A final examination shall be the last summary or comprehensive examination administered before the final awarding of credit for a yearlong or semester course. A mid-term examination shall be the last exam administered at the end of the first semester of a year-long course.
