

The Texas Education Agency released the 2025 accountability ratings on August 15th, 2025 and we here at WISD are excited to be able to once again showcase our accountability ratings to the community following the resolution of legal proceedings that previously prevented their release over the past two years.

Weimar ISD once again stands out among districts in the region. Earning a **“B” rating with an overall score of 89**, Weimar ranked at the top of Colorado County and continues to reflect steady academic growth that places it among the stronger-performing districts across the region and the state of Texas.

Our 2025 results highlight growth in student achievement, particularly in reading and math progress. These gains, paired with a consistently strong graduation rate and low dropout rate, along with a top level commitment to College, Career, and Military readiness, underscore our commitment to academic excellence.

While the letter grade demonstrates success, I would be remiss not to point out that Weimar ISDs true strength lies in what the accountability ratings cannot fully measure—the relationships, the care, and the culture that define daily life in our schools.

At the core of Weimar ISD is a **culture of “WE”**—a shared belief that teachers, students, families, and the community grow stronger together.
