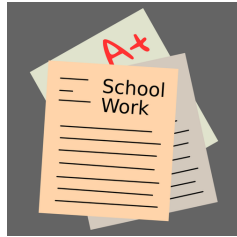


Weimar ISD Meal Distribution

Weimar ISD wants to support our school community by providing a free breakfast and lunch for our WISD families. Beginning Wednesday, March 25, 2020, to all children ages 0-18.

Meals will be available for pickup at Weimar Elementary (515 W. Main) through the circle drive nearest the cafeteria. Pickup will be from 11:30 am - 12:30 pm Monday thru Friday. District staff will deliver food to the vehicle; families will not need to exit the vehicle to receive the meals. Children **MUST** be present in the car to receive the meal.

We will do our best to accommodate all children while supplies last.



Instructional Support

Parents and students are accountable for the learning of their students to the full extent possible during this extended school closure.

Teachers, counselors, and administrators will continue to be available for the duration of the school closure via email and Remind message. Teacher and staff email addresses and Remind codes can be found on the district website, schools, staff websites.

Paper packets for instruction will be available for pick up for all students in grades PK-12th beginning this Wednesday, March 25th at the Weimar Elementary, Weimar Junior High and Weimar High School Circle Drives between 11 am and 1 pm. This packet is due back to the student's campus on Friday, March 27th. Designated drop-boxes will be available for each grade level, on each campus for completed student work. The week of March 30 - April 3, paper packets for instruction are available to be picked up on Friday, March 27th from each designated campus. Pick-up will be on your own accord.

Packets and assignments are due every Friday. Should you wish to submit the packet electronically, please email the assignment to the classroom teacher. Students are required to complete all assignments and turn them in weekly. We promise to work together with everyone to continually evaluate and adjust the process to best meet everyone's needs.



STAAR and End-of-Course (EOC) Exams

Governor Abbott announced that STAAR assessments are waived for the 2019-2020 school year. Additionally, he is requesting that the U.S. Department of Education waive the federal testing requirements. This includes all forms and subjects of STAAR. TEA will provide guidance on graduation requirements as they relate to EOC assessments, and we will update seniors as information becomes available.



Blinn Dual Credit
