The application packet must be complete, arranged in the order listed below, and it <u>must be received by March 29, 2024</u>. The application is not to exceed 15 pages. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Scholarships are judged and awarded without regard to gender, race, color, religion, national origin, or disability. **NOTE**: Applications may be typed, computer generated, or printed neatly in ink. Scholarship winners will be notified via letter and through their school.

CHECK LIST:

- Student Cover Sheet (may be typed or neatly printed in ink).
- Letters of recommendation from two (2) teachers, or (1) teacher and one (1) administrator.
 Letters should cover applicant's ability, work habits, integrity, character, potential, and volunteer activities.
- Most recent transcript of high school (must indicate class rank, size, and test scores, if available). All scholarships with a grade point average (GPA) are based on 4.0 scale
- List of extra-curricular activities, honors received, and scholastic achievements (one side of 8 ½" x 11" paper).
- Essay of 1,000 words or less setting forth student's career objectives.
