The application packet must be complete, arranged in the order listed below, and it must be postmarked by March 27, 2026. The application is not to exceed 15 pages. Incomplete applications will not be considered. **NOTE:** Applications may be typed, computer generated, or printed neatly in ink. Scholarship winners will be notified via letter and through their school counselor.

### CHECK LIST:

- Student Cover Sheet (may be typed or neatly printed in ink).
- Letters of recommendation from two (2) teachers, or (1) teacher and one (1) administrator. Letters should cover applicant's ability, work habits, integrity, character, potential, and volunteer activities.
- Most recent transcript of high school (indicate class rank, size, and test scores, if available). All scholarships with a grade point average (GPA) are based on 4.0 scale
- List of extracurricular activities, honors received, and scholastic achievements (one side of 8 ½" x 11" paper).
- Essay of 1,000 words or less setting forth student's career objectives.
